This Agreement gives permission to you for a performance of live music, the playing of recorded music, or an exhibition of a film but only in accordance with the Deregulation Act 2015, that is that it takes place between 08:00 and 23:00, and that you get permission in advance from us.  
The hall is not licensed for the sale of alcohol. If alcohol is to be sold (for example by a licensed premises providing an outside bar), you must give us notice of this, and you must apply for a TEN (Temporary Event Notice) to the Local Authority.
  
- 8. You agree with us to be present (by your authorised representative, if appropriate) during the hiring and to comply fully with this Agreement.
  
- 9. None of the provisions of this Agreement are intended to or will operate to confer any benefit pursuant to the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 on a person who is not named as a party to this Agreement.
